This is an exciting opportunity to take part in an international experience with full support before, during and after the event.

You don't have to be in any specific section to be part of the leadership team, you just need to have a sense of adventure and great team building and leadership skills.

BACKGROUND

A European Jamboree gathers young people from all over Europe to celebrate Scout and Guide values, strengthen our international community and provide young people with the opportunity to meet and learn from each other.

In 2005, the UK hosted the last European Scout Jamboree, EuroJam, at Hylands Park. Fifteen years on and the European Jamboree is back for 2020, this time in Gdansk, Poland. The Jamboree will focus on building on the fantastic programme developed as part of their World Scout Jamboree bid.

The Scouts and Guides of Poland have invited you to join them, along with a group of Leicestershire Scouts, for 11 days of activities, combining the chance to develop new skills, make new friends and experience Poland's beautiful countryside.

Based on its own island close to the city of Gdansk, the purpose-built site is within walking distance of beautiful sandy beaches, pine forests and a short bus ride from the bustling city.

The UK Scout Association has allocated our County a full unit consisting of four leaders and 36 young people. What's even more exciting is the UKSA has decided to take a less centralised role in planning and let the unit leaders plan the event with their young people!

With almost two years to plan, your role will be to support the selection of young people, work with the young people to agree a programme for the unit, prepare the participants for the camp experience, complete necessary training, assist with fundraising, manage the communications and finances.
